Title:	Food Service Assistant

Summary:

Working as part of the Catering Team, the Food Service Assistant plays an important role in the delivery of a full range of catering services for the Heriot's Community including pupils, staff, governors and visitors.

Main Duties:

Reporting to the Hospitality and Catering Manager the duties of the Food Service Assistant include:

- Provision of a friendly and efficient food service to customers
- Stock replenishment as required
- Provide assistance at functions and events
- Cleaning both basic and deep cleaning
- Assisting Early Year Children
- Adherence to food safety legislation
- Undertake Training as required to ensure compliance with Health and Safety and Food Safety legislation
- Attend meetings as may be necessary from time to time
- Any other duties as deemed reasonable and necessary by the Catering Manager.

Skills and Attributes:

- Previous experience of working as a Food Service or Catering Assistant in a formal working environment
- Basic Food Hygiene Certificate
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to work both individually and as part of a team in a busy kitchen environment
- Willingness to undertake training and development in line with department/school requirements and in line with Food Safety legislation
