The successful candidate will be an accomplished tenor and/or bass drummer with a strong background in both performance and teaching.

Key Responsibilities

- Deliver individual tenor and bass drum lessons of 40 minutes duration.
- Attend and support Pipe Band rehearsals during term time.
- Help pupils develop the full range of skills needed to perform in a Pipe Band, including in competitions, parades, concerts, and other public performances.
- Support the development of flourishing and flourishing choreography in tenor drumming.
- Encourage and support the musical development of pupils of varying abilities and experience levels.

Person Specification

- Demonstrated excellence in tenor and/or bass drumming performance.
- Experience teaching individuals and groups across a range of ages and abilities.
- Ability to compose and notate flourishing patterns and bass/tenor drum scores.
- Knowledge of drum set-up and maintenance.
- Competence in basic administration using Excel, Word, and email.
- Ability to write concise and informative termly reports.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills.
- Willingness to attend competitions, parades, tours, and other relevant events.
