The Role

Reporting to the Head of Grounds, the primary role of the Gardener is to maintain, manage and improve all House gardens and amenity areas to a high standard.

Key Responsibilities

- Routine maintenance, future planning and enhancement of all garden areas.
- Carry out procedures required to maintain and improve to a high quality.
- Soft landscaping works as required.
- Drive and operate vehicles in a safe manner as required for grounds maintenance operations.
- Ensure all grounds vehicles and equipment used by self and work group are regularly maintained in accordance with routine operating requirements reporting defects as required.
- Safe use, storage, calibration and disposal of pesticides and other similar substances.
- Work areas are kept clean, tidy and secure at all times.
- Establish effective working relationships with managers and colleagues.
- Work in line with established safe working practices and procedures.
- Promote the Health & Safety of others.

- A good knowledge of hand tools and their usage.

Benefits

This is a permanent full-time or part time role. Full time hours are 35.6 hours per week Monday to Thursday (8 am to 4 pm, with a 30 min lunch break and 2 x 15 min break) and Friday (8 am to 3 pm with a 30 min lunch break and 1 x 15 min break) with 4 hours on every $3^{\rm rd}$ Saturday morning. All breaks are unpaid.

Annual Salary: £ 28,600 (prorated for part time)

Staff Benefits: In addition to being part of a great team you will be entitled to a range of benefits that include:

- 30 days holidays and 8 days public holidays (full time), generally taken outside term time.
- Parking within the campus grounds. The campus is easily accessed by car and bus; there is a bus stop located outside the campus serving several routes across the city and to rail stations.
- Membership of Westwoods gym and health club which offers a range of excellent fitness and leisure facilities including a 25m swimming pool.

- Free lunchtime meals during term time, and at other times when catering is provided, and you are on duty.
- Life insurance scheme.
- Excellent Employee Assistance Programme (EAP).
- You will be opted into the Fettes College Pension Plan after 3 months service. This scheme is a money purchase one, operating as a salary exchange plan. The College will contribute to the scheme a minimum of 8% and you will contribute a minimum of 2%. Fettes operate a contribution matching scheme up to 12% of base salary.
- Access to discounted healthcare, additional life insurance, shopping discounts, etc through our 4me benefits portal.


