- the delivery of dinghy sailing and powerboating and;
- Gordonstoun International Summer School.

Responsibilities of all members of staff:

- Carry out any other task as required from time to time in order to support the school.

Major responsibilities of the role:

- Liaise with Sail Training Operations and Training Manager, domestic services, refectory & transport to ensure efficient organisation of Sail Training voyages.
- Liaise with the Healthcare and pastoral leads to determine how to support students with health and wellbeing needs.
- Oversee daily vessel position and route plan monitoring.
- Liaise with ASTO and other funding bodies over the administration of external funds and bursaries available for Sail Training.
- Monitor the production of formal written reports about students as part of the school's reporting system.
- Support the delivery of dinghy sailing and powerboating.
- Support the delivery of Gordonstoun International Summer School sail training.
