Summary of Position:

Main Duties:

Based on the School's main campus and responsible to the Estates Works Manager, the main duties of the Electrician include but are not limited to:

Executing, to a high standard, all electrical tasks, as directed. These include:

- Upgrading of existing circuits and lighting
- Installation of cable containment systems
- Inspection and Testing of existing and new systems
- Ensure all Health and Safety procedures are adhered to at all times
- Ensure the care, safe storage and stock control of all materials and equipment used.
- Any other duties as deemed reasonable and necessary by the Premises Works Manager

- Fully qualified Electrician (valid grade card and 18th Edition certified)
- Good knowledge of electrical/mechanical installations, single and 3 phase power.
- Ability to trace faults, problem solve and seek solutions to faults and failures.
