It is essential that you are capable of teaching Business Studies at GCSE Level and either BTEC or A Level.

You will have a recognised teaching qualification and be registered with the GTCS or in the process of achieving this. Economics or BTEC experience would be beneficial, but is not essential.

You will possess the following qualities:

- a high level of academic qualification in Business Studies
- the ability to plan, prepare and deliver creative and challenging lessons to all age groups
- the confidence to use innovative teaching methods that enhance learning and teaching



## **Our pupils**

The Lorettonian community is diverse and inclusive. We welcome pupils from 25 different countries, expanding the horizons of all our pupils. In addition, our bursaries and scholarships mean that no matter a child's financial background, a Loretto education is accessible.

Loretto pupils are well-rounded and determined. With a 99% A Level pass rate in 2024, pupils at the school perform exceptionally well academically. However, as every pupil is encouraged to pursue their individual interests, excellent achievements are evident everywhere – from the arts to the sports pitches and golf courses.





## **Our Staff**

We have a very friendly and supportive Common Room with a wide range of interests and life stories. The demographic of the staff is varied from newly qualified teachers to those who know the school and its history inside out. #### Wider school responsibilities
